YIMBERT BACKS FORT HUNTER.
Fort Hunter delighted N. Yimbert by his showing in his workout. The Canadian colt went the Derby distance in 2:37, and after the colt had cooled out Yimbert said a future race would be a good one for him on his colt, getting odds of 8 to 1.
