ENDS STRENUOUS DAY AT ALPENA

Senator Burrows Speaks to Several Large Crowds in the North Country.

Alpena, Mich., August 16.—Senator Burrows spent a strenuous day with a speech from the city hall steps to a big crowd in the city tonight. His audience packed the square in front of the municipal building, and frequently applauded his speech.

Senator Burrows repeated his endorsement of President Taft and the proposed legislation on the considerable length on the latter subject.

On his arrival in the city he was greeted by a delegation of Alpena's prominent business men, headed by Frank D. Burrows, his personal friend. At the conclusion of Senator Burrows' speech Mayor Dafford made a few remarks in which he called to the attention of the audience the fact that it was through the Senator's efforts that the additional appropriation of \$10,000 had been secured for the new Alpena post office.

The party made an early start this morning, traveling by train to 8 o'clock on the Detroit & Mackinac railroad and taking breakfast at Millersburg, on the way to Alpena. The first meeting of the day was held at 9 o'clock in the Millersburg town hall, where a large number of people was addressed. An auto trip to Onaway gave the senator a good opportunity to inspect the town, met by a big crowd and a hand. He talked first from an automobile on the main street, then in a rain to a good crowd. Then he was taken to the big plant of the Loderer Brothers, where he addressed the 500 employees. The senator will get a big vote from the men, who are the backbone of the company, he received. The company has branch factories in Germany and France.

From Onaway the senator drove to Tower, where he shook hands with several hundred men and women.

IN CHAIR OF EMBRYOLOGY

Dr. Huber, of U. of M., Accepts Unique Position in East.
