BOARD TO SURVEY LEAKY RESERVOIR

Mayor Hall Will Name Three Engineers to Report on Twin Peaks Job.

EVASION IS IMPOSSIBLE.

Responsibility for the Blunder Must Now Be Placed Where It Belongs.

A full investigation of the Twin Peaks reservoir by a board of three engineers to be appointed by the Mayor is to be held. In spite of the efforts to mask the larger question of the work done by the contractor, the Mayor has determined upon an open hearing by a specially appointed board of three engineers to report on the work done by the contractor. The board will be composed of three engineers to be named by the Mayor. The board will be held at the City Engineer's office on Tuesday night. A conference was held yesterday morning between the board and the contractor, Mr. J. H. Healy, head of the contracting firm. At the beginning of the conference, the Mayor's plan to have the contractor put up the job that has already been done, but it soon became evident that any arrangement that could be made to avoid the responsibility of the contractor would be to the presumption that all the facts were made in design.
