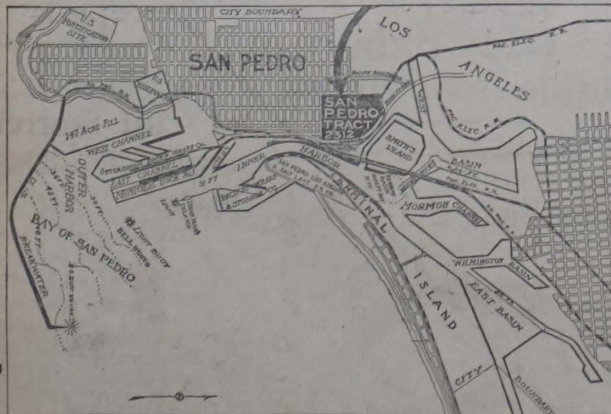

DISMISS CASE AGAINST MOVIE MANAGER

Christine Neal Still Missing and

J. P. Hartigan Goes

Free

Behind the words "For Lack of Evidence," which resulted in the dismissal of contributory charges against J. P. Hartigan, manager of a motion picture firm, lies the story of a girl's love—a girl who battled officers by her whim and is now a fugitive from justice.

The girl was Christine Neal, aged 17. Hartigan was charged with contributing to her delinquency by taking her out on joyrides. The same charge was made against J. F. Manly and Richard Hollingsworth. Ready to give all the testimony needed against the latter, Miss Neal refused to utter one word against Hartigan.

"I love him too much," she declared at the time.

Cajolery, pleas, threats—all failed to wring from her lips the story of her relations with Hartigan. As punishment she was sent to Whittier. From there she escaped and she has never been traced.

The case against Hartigan was dismissed today in Justice Willis' court.

100,000 SPINELESS CACTUS SOLD BY BURBANK CO.

ROSE EXPLAINS HIS STAND ON GAS CASE

Council Must Act First Regarding McReynolds Says the Mayor

Mayor Rose today defined his attitude on the attack made against President O. O. McReynolds of the Board of Public Utilities. The Mayor stated that he would not initiate any proceedings in the gas controversy, as he believed it to be the duty of the council to start action.

"I have informed several members of the council who have inquired that if a request came from the council asking me to remove President McReynolds I would give it serious consideration and probably would accede to the request," said the Mayor.

"However, I refused to initiate proceedings in the natural gas case. If the council arrives at the opinion that any officer of the city government should be removed from office its recommendation will carry a great deal of weight. But it is the duty of the Mayor under the charter to pass judgment on the council's acts, and for that reason the veto power is vested in him."

SHRINERS TO GIVE PAGEANT OF DESERT

In the hot desert wind and amid the whirl of the drifting sand, members of Al Malakah temple, Nobles of the Myrtle Shrine, will produce in Shrine auditorium tomorrow night, El Caravan, a ceremonial staged by Charles Glynn, written by annual Dym, with Fred Bradley as master of mechanical effects and illustrious Potentate Leo V. Youngworth in the leading role. The dress rehearsal will be held tonight.

Besides the 500 members of Al Malakah temple participating in the production, six camels, one elephant, one masted cow, one dozen burros and twenty-four Arabian horses will be utilized to place on the floor of the Shrine auditorium a scene from the desert land.

As an audience the Al Malakah nobles will have visitors, hands and patrols from Islam temple, San Francisco, Ahmies temple, Oakland, and Al Ahir temple, San Diego, who will arrive here tomorrow. This will mark the first merger of the hands and patrols which will be in the make up of the Hands Around the State 1913 Shrine Concert company, which will go on a road tour through California the latter part of this month to raise a fund to equip the special booster trains of California, which will be sent east next spring.

AT 120 HE SEEKS TO TAKE A SEVENTH WIFE

RALEIGH, N. C., Oct. 2.—Joseph McIntyre, declaring himself 120 years old, asked the Bladen county register of deeds for a license to take his seventh wife. All the preceding six have died in wedlock.
