

SEEKS OPINION
ON CAMPAIGN
ORDINANCE

Betkowski to Ask Legal Department to Decide Whether Such Law Could Be Enforced

When the ordinance regulating the expenditure of funds for campaign purposes is voted on before the public works committee of the council tomorrow, City Attorney Stephens will be asked by Comptroller Betkowski to decide if the Dunlop-Reed ordinance can be enforced if it is adopted.

The chief deputy in the attorney's office, Howard Robertson, has already held an informal meeting, stating that the provisions of the ordinances are inconsistent, and that in his opinion its passage would be unsafe.

"I believe it would be a rank piece of foolishness to pass the ordinance and I shall vote against it," said Comptroller Betkowski.

"It evidently appears to Mr. Dunlop's intent to have an election campaign to spend any money for campaign literature, cards, or to hire any employees to work for a candidate or a measure for a period of 30 days preceding an election."

The ordinance also provides that anyone who has worked for money in the interests of a candidate or a measure for thirty days before an election may not contribute their services on election day.

"In another section the hiring of automobile drivers and chauffeurs to the polls is prohibited. If I wanted to hire an automobile to take my own wife to the polls, as I have done in the past, at the election it would be deemed an infraction of the law. If it was ever passed, I should ask if it were intended to cover this kind of foolishness," said Comptroller Betkowski.
