

91st to Open Its Annual Training

California's 91st Division of Army reservists, with headquarters at the Presidio, will begin two weeks of summer training Sunday at five separate military installations in the West.

For the first time, the division will devote the period to its new mission—training all instructors rather than as a combat unit. Under the recent "pentomic" reorganization the 91st would, in the future, move to a military center to train thousands of soldiers.

The main body of reservists will go to Camp Roberts (San Luis Obispo County) as in previous years. The division is commanded by Maj. Gen. Stuart D. Menist of San Francisco.

The division could train, in the event of mobilization, more than 11,000 troops in fields ranging from infantry and armor to mechanics and cooks, Menist said.
